1. Who can enter?

First through sixth grade students

2. What mediums or categories of art are allowed?

Painting [watercolor, oil, and acrylic], Monochromatic, Polychromatic

3. What art may students enter?

Students may enter art work produced during regular art class time, after-school art lessons, or art work produced outside of class.

4. How are students judged?

All art work is judged based on student's grade level and skill.

5. Where to turn in art work?

All art work should be turned into Mrs. Bliss in the Art room. Mrs. Bliss will give students a form to fill out and attach to their art work.

6. When will winners be announced?

At the beginning of May

7. When will awards be given?

At the awards ceremony in May

8. Will the art be involved in any shows?

Yes, all art work produced in art classes will be shown in the "Work in Progress Show" which is in the Fall. Also, after-school art and art competition results are usually shown in May.

9. Will the art be returned?

Yes, in May

Contest begins the first week of school in September

Deadline for art is the last week of April
